

#### Local reles

#### 1. Out of boudns

 Marked by white stakes and fances, or by red lines on the kerb of the path at holes 9 and 15

#### 2. Penalty Areas

- Penalty areas are marked by yellow / red stakes.
- On holes 2, 3, 4, and 5 is the margin of red penalty areas defined by the edge of stony paving of the lake and its inflow and the edge of palisade
- Unmarked watercourse and drainage channels are ment to be red penalty areas.
- In case there is any unmarked penalty areas or its part the margins of the penalty areas are its natural boundaries
- No Play Zone on holes 2, 3,4 and 5 are marked by red-green stakes and are red penalty areas. Entry and play from here is prohibited. Player has to take relief from penalty area. In case of interference of No Play zone in player's stance or his intended swing, the player must take relief (as GUR)

# 3. Ground under repair (Abnormal Course Condition)

- Is marked by blue stakes or by blue or white line on the ground
- Tyre traces on the shortly mown areas
- Trees with stakes
- Repared or newly seeded areas
- 4. **Power line** (Hole no. 3)
- After hitting the power line (any part wires, pylon) player must repeat the shot under no penalty

# 5. Immovable obstructions

- All parts of irrigation system
- Benches, ball cleaners, information system on the holes, advertisements, distance markers and bins
- All paths and grassless areas nearby
- Bridges on the holes 3, 5, 9, 11.
- Artificial drainage in General Area with or without grill
- Decorative bed around the club house bordered by concreate kerb

# 6. Movable obstructions

- All mobile parts of information system
- Stones in bunkers

# 7. Dropping zone

\* is marked by black markers. Its margins are defined the same way as Teeing Ground.

\* if ball is in red penalty area in the lake on right side or in the No play zone on the left side, player may drop the ball to droppintg zone as aditional option while proceding under 17 (under 1 penalty stroke)
